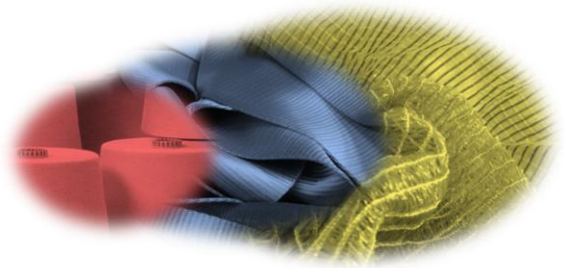

INVITATION TO MULTIPLIER EVENT IN LITHUANIA

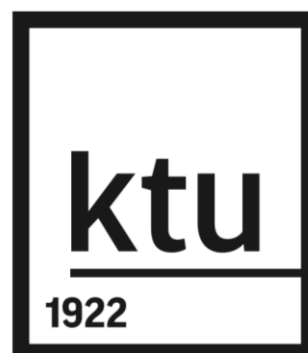
Upcoming multiplier event

Meeting in Terrassa

TEXSTRA partnership had its second, successful meeting, at Terrassa (ES), home of AEI TEXTILS at Leitat Technological center facilities on May 11th 2018.

The partnership reviewed the progress made since the project start in September 2017. The status of the national and European reports on the learning needs analysis was presented. They are based on the survey responses gathered within the textile and clothing sector in the participating countries.



Ongoing activities

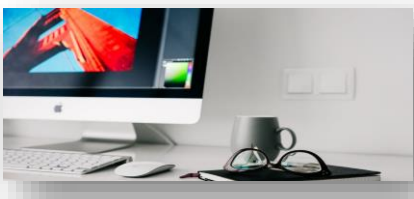
TEXSTRA partners are performing the design of the capacity building training macrostructure to enable transferring research and innovation, and the setting up of the online platform. In the upcoming months the desk research will be published on the project website.
